Our child-led learning this week will be focusing on...

UTW: People, Culture and Communities

In Maths...

When comparing, children notice attributes and begin to understand differences and similarities. The activities this week will focus on further developing this innate skill as the children are encouraged to focus exclusively on the numerosity of sets, without being diverted by colour, shape or size. They will then be encouraged to notice when quantities are equal or unequal, and will begin to consider how they can manipulate the number of objects in 2 sets to make them equal.



In Literacy....

This week we will be writing the short version of our class story 'Let's all creep through crocodile creek'. Children will be using the Mighty Writer story mat to rehearse the story and then write parts of it. We will be focusing on children forming letters correctly and spelling words using the phonic sounds they know.



As part of our class phonics...

Children will now complete their daily phonics teaching in smaller reading groups, taught by different adults. In class, we will be reviewing all Set 1 sounds together and working on our oral blending skills. We are currently focusing on reading the tricky words **go, said, your**. During shared writing we will be focusing applying the phonics we know to spell words.
