UTW – The Natural World: Birds and Farm Animals

In Maths...

This week, the children will continue to engage with activities that draw attention to the purpose of counting – to find out 'how many' objects there are. They will continue to be provided with opportunities to hear, join in with and develop their knowledge of the counting sequence and to become secure enough with their counting skills to be able to count out a set of objects from a larger set and knowing that this means they have selected the correct number.

In Literacy....

We will be starting a new class text this week called *'The Pirates Are Coming'*. We will focus on a lot of prediction and vocabulary development this week, providing opportunities to talk, give opinions and develop imaginative ideas.

Children will complete writing tasks focusing on finger spaces.



As part of our class phonics...

Children complete their daily phonics sessions in smaller reading groups, taught by different adults. In class, we will be reviewing all Set 1 special friends together and introducing some set 2 sounds, including **ay** and **ee**. We are currently focusing on reading the tricky words **your** and **he**. During shared writing we will be focusing applying the phonics we know to spell words.
