In Maths...

A key focus this week is to use the children's developing understanding of doubles to support their subitising skills. By moving away from counting for sets that can be subitised, the children will develop their abstract understanding of number, which will help to support future calculation strategies. This week's sessions will also continue to encourage the children to consider when they can subitise and when they might need counting as a strategy.



In Literacy....

We will continue to read our class story 'Silly Doggy' this week, focusing on all the things Doggy does that are silly. We will be learning about speech bubbles and what we write inside of them. We will be learning more about Silly Doggy and what he likes to do. We will also find out that more animals have escaped from the zoo and that the zoo keepers need help. Lots of writing this week!



As part of our class phonics...

Children complete their daily phonics sessions in smaller reading groups, taught by different adults. In class, we will be reviewing all Set 1 special friends and set 2 sounds together, including **igh** and **ay**. We are currently focusing on reading the tricky words **are, she, you, me, all**. During shared writing we will be focusing applying the phonics we know to spell words.
