

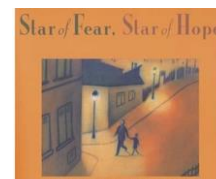


Team 6 Autumn Home Learning

You can support your child's learning at home in the following areas:

Maths

This half term we will be learning about:



- Place up to millions (understanding the value of each digit in these numbers).
- Rounding numbers (for example 1074 rounded to the nearest 10 is 1070)
- Negative numbers (understand their worth and +, - negative numbers – e.g. $-17 + 2 = -15$)

Times Tables

This half term we will be learning the following times tables and the corresponding division facts:

Reviewing all facts up to 12×12

For example:

$$4 \times 8 = 32$$

$$32 \text{ divided by } 8 = 4$$

It will support your child's Maths to use TTRockstars at least 3 times a week. I will be reviewing their progress and speed regularly.



Spelling

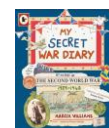
We will be learning the following common exception words from the joint Year 5/6 list this half term:
