ACTIVITIES

ADMISSIONS

Children are eligible to attend 'Early Birds and Night Owls' once they are three. Parents are asked to complete all relevant registration forms and a contract prior to their child attending.

SAFE AND SECURE

Your child's safety and well-being is our paramount concern, and it is vital that parents feel confident they can leave their children in our care, knowing they are safe. Safeguarding and promoting children's welfare is a large part of our statutory responsibilities and covers most of the requirements of our registration with Ofsted. Our staff are all recruited with particular care and attention, references are fully investigated, and every member of staff undergoes enhanced criminal record bureau checks.

We ensure the safety and security of the premises and equipment by the following means:

- 'Early Birds and Night Owls' has a sign in/ sign out register system.
- Play areas inside and outside the building are safe, with fences and gates fully secured.
- Relevant risk assessments are in place and are reviewed as and when required.
- All equipment and toys are suitable and safe for the children, and all are checked regularly for breakages and faults.

MEDICINES

Please only ask our staff to administer medicines when it is essential. You will be asked to fill out a medicine administration form with the relevant information, if you require staff to administer medication. Please speak to a member of staff for more details.

REGISTRATION FORMS AND PAPERWORK

Please be aware that a place for your child can only be secured when all relevant registration forms/ paperwork has been completed and passed onto Mrs Hayward, and all payments have been received.

FOR MORE INFORMATION

Parents are the primary educators of their children and should be centrally involved in their child's experiences and development. We work closely with parents to provide a level of care that meets the high standards you'd expect for your child.

We welcome parents' comments and consult on a regular basis about how 'Early Birds and Night Owls' is managed and the services we offer. We are always open to new ideas and welcome any parent/ carer who would like to spend some time at 'Early Birds and Night Owls' or who can contribute by bringing their skills to broaden our activities. The staff at 'Early Birds and Night Owls,' who form part of our provision, are always willing to meet with you and discuss your child's progress or answer any questions you may have.

Effective communication means there is a two-way flow of information, knowledge and expertise between parents and staff. When you come to collect your child, your child's Key Worker will tell you all about his or her day, activities, or achievements.
