<p><b>Transport</b> A way of moving things from place to place.</p> 	<p><b>Map</b> A drawing of all or part of the Earth's surface. Maps show where things are.</p> 	<p><b>Rail</b> A type of transport that carries people or goods on wheeled vehicles that are on tracks.</p> 
<p><b>Journey</b> Travelling from one place to another.</p>	<p><b>Direction</b> The way in which someone or something moves.</p> 	<p><b>Ferry</b> A boat or ship that is used to take people, vehicles or goods across large bodies of water such as seas, lakes and rivers.</p>
<p><b>Travel</b> To go from one place to another, sometimes over a long distance.</p>	<p><b>Road</b> A prepared flat surface on which vehicles carry people or goods.</p> 	<p><b>Bus</b> A large wheeled vehicle meant to carry many passengers along with the bus driver. It is larger than a car or van.</p>
<p><b>Vehicle</b> A thing used for transporting people or goods, especially on land, such as a car or lorry</p>	<p><b>Air</b> The movement of people or goods by aircraft such as aeroplanes or helicopters.</p> 	<p><b>Train</b> A series of connected railway carriages moved by a locomotive.</p>
