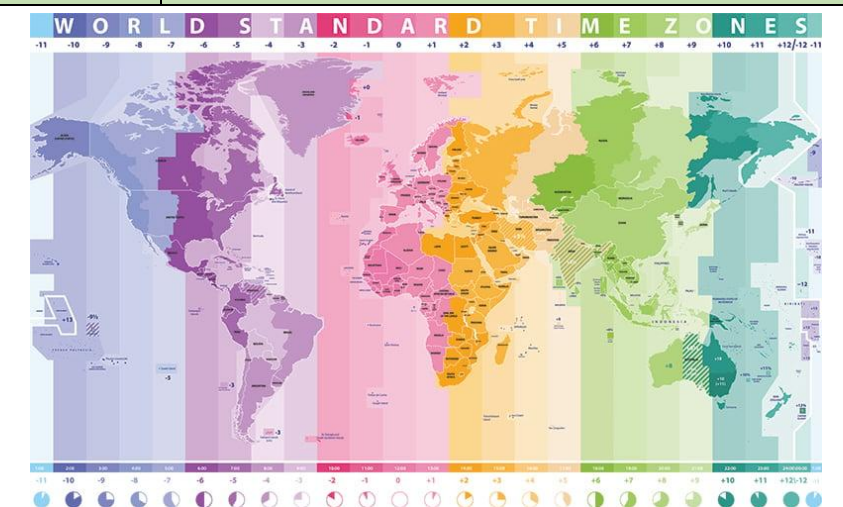
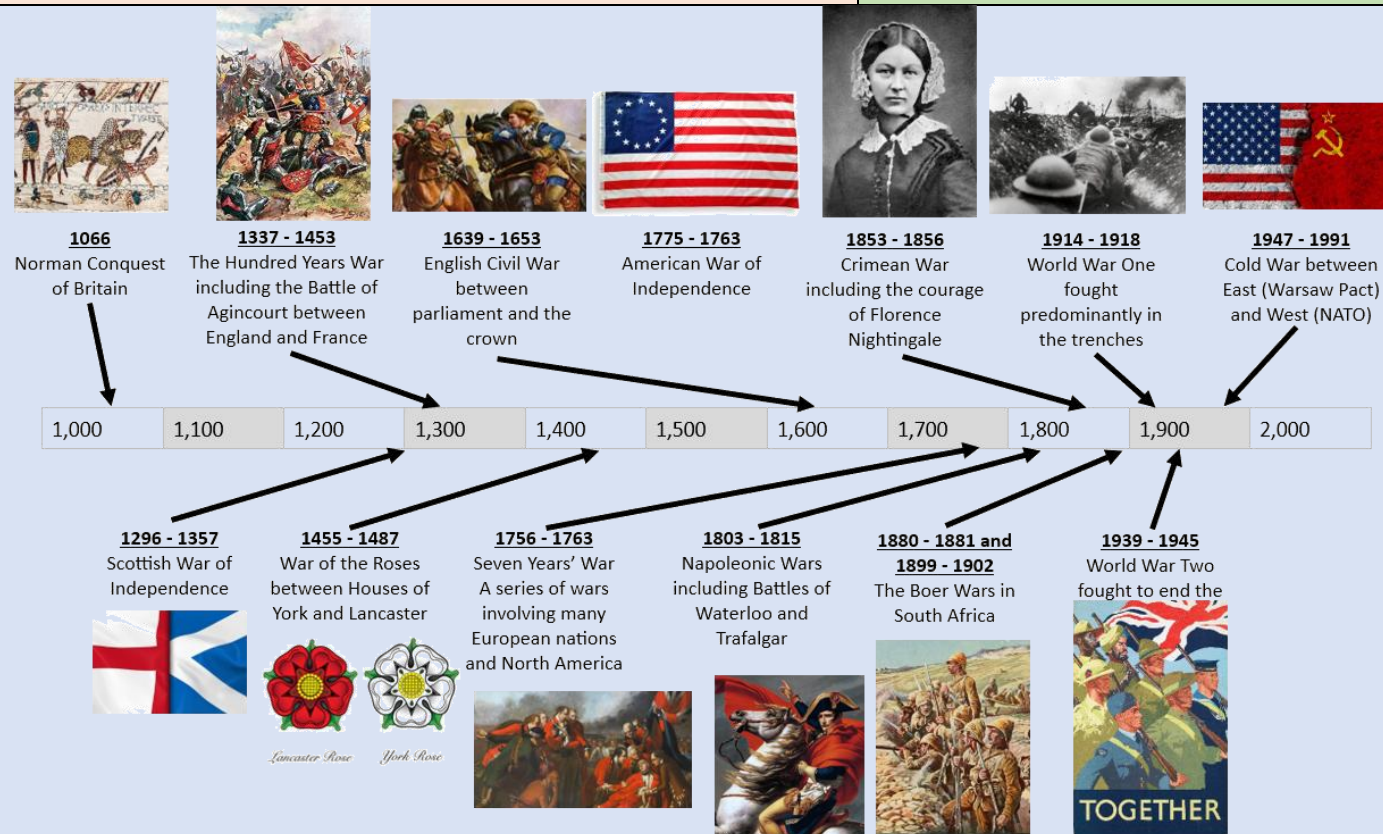
religion

Time Zones

It takes 24 hours for the Earth to rotate once on its axis. We split the globe into time zones using imaginary lines called *meridians*. They run from the North to the South Pole, crossing lines of latitude. There are 24 time zones.

There is an imaginary line running through the UK called the *Prime Meridian*. It runs through a place in London called *Greenwich*. The Prime Meridian splits the world into eastern and western hemispheres

Mass and Weight

The mass of an object is how much matter it is made of and can be measured in grams/kilograms.

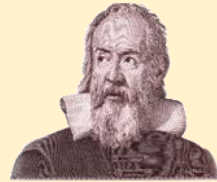


Weight is how much gravitational force is needed to pull an object and is measured in Newtons.

A History of Conflict
