Strand	Focus	Progression Statements
Digital Literacy	E-Safety	• Make decisions about whether or not statements or images found on the Internet are likely to be true. • Identify different devices that can go on the Internet, and separate those that do not. • Identify what counts as personal information. • Identify what to do when inappropriate content is accessed.
	Research	• Talk about websites they have been on. • Explore a website by clicking on buttons, arrows, menus and hyperlinks. • Navigate 'back' by clicking on the 'back' button.
Computer Science	Programming using Beebots	• Describe and use instructions to program a character. • Use instructions to make characters move in different directions and distances. • Use a repeat instruction to make a sequence of instructions run more than once. • Create a program with a sequence of linked instructions. • Locate and fix bugs in a self-made program.
Information Technology	Paint	• Draw a simple picture. • Paint with different colours and brushes. • Create shapes and fill areas. • Make changes and improve work.
	Filming	• Use a digital camera or iPad to take pictures. • Be aware that digital pictures and video can be saved on a computer.
	Computer Skills	• Use both hands on the keyboard. • Talk about how they are using ICT. • Start to use appropriate ICT vocabulary. • Use a trackpad. • Switch on and shutdown a computer.
