This term we will be learning:

<u>In English</u>, our texts are Rose Blanche and Hansel & Gretel and we will be writing a diary, narrative and diary entry.

In grammar, we will be focusing on:

- **Punctuation** (commas to separate clauses, semi-colons in a list and to mark clause boundaries and dashes)
- **Spelling** (homophones, *ough* rule, *'ei/ie'* rule and the Y5/6 word list.
- **Sentence level** (informal/formal language and how words are related through synonyms/antonyms).

In maths, we will be focusing on:

- Place value (rounding, negative numbers, ordering numbers)
- Core operations and methods (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division)
- **Fractions** (equivalent, compare and order, add and subtract, fractions of amounts and multiplying/dividing fractions).

In science, our topics are the circulatory system and electricity.

In computing, we will be learning _____ and ____.

In RE, we will be learning about world views and current affairs.

<u>In geography</u>, we will be learning about mountains and the geographical features.

<u>In French</u>, we will be learning about pets and our homes.

<u>In art and design</u>, we will be learning how art can help us to express our identity and emotion.

<u>In D&T</u>, we will be learning how to plan and construct model mountains based upon existing mountains around the world.
