English

This half term in English, we will be reading an exciting new book called Secrets of a Sun King by Emma Carroll! We will be exploring the plot, settings, and characters throughout the text. The children will write their own chapter for the book continuing the storyline.



Maths

Some of the topics in Maths for this half term include:

- Place value up to 6-digits, including decimals.
- Adding and subtracting increasingly large numbers, using formal written methods and mental strategies.
- Multiplying and dividing numbers including decimals, money and measures.
- Perimeter and area of rectangles and composite rectilinear shapes.

Self-portraits - We will be investigating self-portraits by a range of artists; children will use photographs of themselves as a starting point for developing their own unique self-portraits in mixed media.

In History, we will be studying Ancient Egypt. We will begin by exploring the contents of the tomb of Tutankhamun. Then, we will create a timeline to show how ancient

Computing

Children will develop their understanding of computer systems and how information is transferred between systems and devices.
