MOUNT PLEASANT PRIMARY SCHOOL SPRING 1 YEAR 5

English

This half term we will be studying The Paperbag Prince by Colin Thompson. Through this, we will learn about plastic pollution and waste management. We will learn how to write persuasively by writing a leaflet all about landfill.



Science

The children will be exploring the different stages of human development, and changes which occur from birth to old age.

Geography and History

How has everyday life changed since our parents and grandparents were 10? We will be investigating changes in technology and entertainment, and also looking at how the local area has evolved in the last 150 years.

Music

We will focus on the song 'Livin' on a Prayer' – a rock song from the 1980s by Bon Jovi, as well as other rock songs from the 20^{th} century.

<u>DT</u>

Mechanical Systems

This half term in DT, we are creating a multi-page pop-up storybook. This book will include a range of mechanisms and decorative features: structures, levers, sliders, layers and spacers.

Maths

Some of the topics in Maths for this half term include:

- Numbers to one million.
- Addition and subtraction in multi-step problems.
- Negative numbers.
- Multiplication and division problems including multiply four-digit numbers by two-digit numbers.
- 2D and 3D shapes.

Computing

This half term the children will be using SCRATCH. They will learn to use code and programming language to create own interactive animations, solar systems, and accessibility aids.

PSHE

Growing and changing. Children will learn to take notice of their feelings, and about how their feelings and bodies can change as they grow older.

<u>Arabic</u>

The children will learn to speak, read, and write in Arabic with a focus on:

- Colours
- Classroom Equipment
- Animals
