MOUNT PLEASANT PRIMARY SCHOOL TERM 1.1 YEAR 4

Autumn1 School Value: **Aspirational**

Science

In science, the children will be learning about electricity. We will discuss which appliances use mains electricity, name the parts of a simple electrical circuit and build a working circuit. The children will also learn about insulators and conductors, and electrical safety.

PSHE

This half term our topic is 'Me and My Relationships'. Children will take part in discussions and will discuss different scenarios, looking at how to navigate different issues.

They will also take part in a lesson about peer pressure and the importance of making good choices.

Design and Technology

The children will be learning about mechanisms by studying how hinges are made and they will design and create their own hinges then incorporate these into a product.

They will also be working with textiles to create a device to stop a tea towel slipping off its hook. They will learn some simple stitches to use in the end product.

Maths

At the end of Year 4, the children are required to sit an official times table check test. Over the year, we will be working to consolidate the times tables that the children already know, and we will be moving on to learn the remaining times tables.

In this first half term, we will be working on reasoning with numbers including thousands. The children will also be developing their addition And subtraction skills with 4 digit numbers.

English

In English, we will be reading Anthony brown's book 'Gorilla'. It is a fantasy book, and at the end of the unit, children will write a fantasy story based on this book.

In this unit, they will be learning to add detail to their writing using expanded noun phrases, to use fronted adverbials followed by a comma to make their sentences more interesting and they will be organising their work in paragraphs.

Geography / History

Pupils will begin learning about the Anglo Saxon invasions of Britain, and how this changed the lives of people living here. As well as this, we will look at Viking life, how they lived and where they invaded and settled.

Religious Education

Children will learn about the different faiths that can be found in our country and more specifically, our local communities.

MFL - Arabic

We will learn the Arabic alphabet and personal information.

Computing

We are coding this half term using a text-based programming language to explore count-controlled loops when drawing shapes.

Music

All the learning for this module will be focused on the band ABBA, with a particular focus on their popular song Mama Mia. The children will learn about different aspects of music through games, singing and composing.
