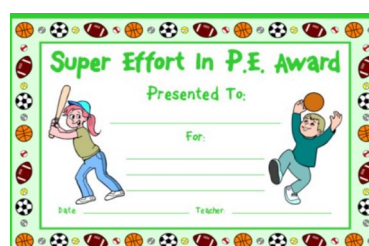

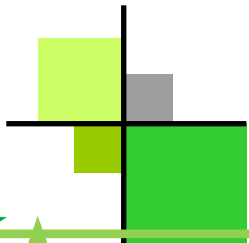


Mr Smith's PE Awards
