Today, Friday 10th October we have celebrated World Mental Health Day.


On behalf of YOUNG MINDS, we thank you all for wearing something YELLOW to school today to show your support for this incredible charity.




Harvest Assembly






Eb per ticket - entrance includes disco, hotdog and a drink.


