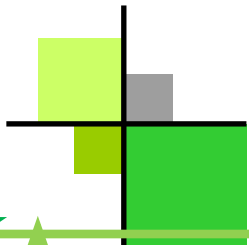

Next week, we will return to our usual format of newsletter with Styal Stars, PE and Headteacher award certificates.

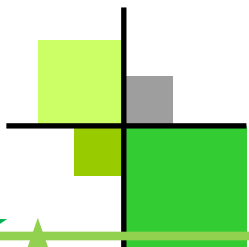
Whole school attendance this week was at **90.61%**
