Please come and support our Y5/6 singers this Sunday, 23rd November, at the Styal Christmas Lights switch on.


Our Styal choir will be singing 5 Christmas songs from 4:45pm until 5:15pm.

Lois has shared some exciting news this week. She has achieved 3 badges at Cubs:



Well done too to Orla for some superb independent Maths work!






