We are all looking forward to our fabulous Christmas fair next Friday and are excited to see you all there.


Our Parents of Styal are working hard to make sure this is another successful event and will be in the playground next week selling tokens and collecting any donations you may have.




Well done to Y3/4 this week who helped keep our local community clean and tidy on their litter pick on Wednesday.

Thank you Year 3/4!





Amazing achievement! Well done Flo!



Very well done Laina – this is a far fastic achievement. We are very proud of you!




