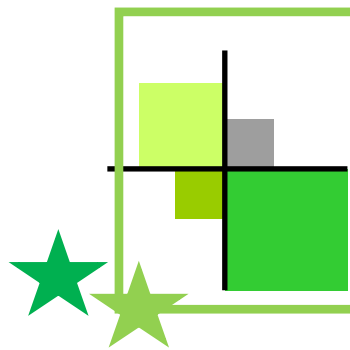

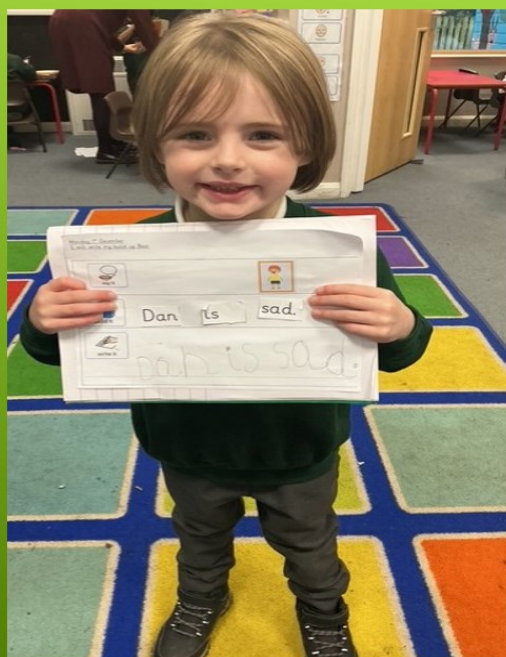

Please remember to feedback to your Parent Council Representatives with regards to the Home School Agreement sent to you all. We value your thoughts and input.

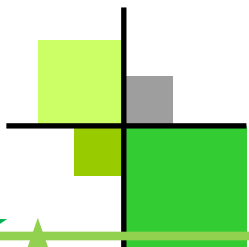
We look forward to welcoming families to the first of our Christmas events next week— **Reception's Nativity**, and don't forget those **Christmas Jumpers on Thursday!**
