It really set the scene as we approach our last week of school before Christmas.


We were all so very proud of the children who were absolutely superb. It was a heart warming afternoon for everyone.

Thank you to all the families who came to watch and support your brilliant children.








Wonderful work this week

Thank you for bee-ing kind Isaac!





Headteacher's Award




Congratulations to Izzy this week in Y3/4.



It was all worth it though as this year's profit is a whopping






