


PLEASE do not block gates when dropping off and picking up your children at school. We ask that you park considerately to keep our school community safe.




Wonderful work this week


Wonderful work this week

Well done to Harlow and Ottolie in Reception too, who wrote about what they received from Santa for Christmas!







Thank you Poppy!




Exciting news from James!
