


As a school community, we highly value showing respect to one another.

Sadly this week, we have received reports that some of our school community have not been respectful to other adults at the end of the school day. This has also been in front of some of our children.


Please help us to model respect and treat one another as we ourselves would like to be treated.

Wonderful work this week




Who doesn't love a game of bingo?!




Lovely work from our Year 1/2 children this week. They have been very busy!

Wonderful work this week




Y3/4 have been so excited this week planning mythical stories in class.

Well done to all of you!


Wonderful work this week


Well done to **Y5/6** who are in full swing with their clarinet lessons each week.




Random Acts of Kindness







Mr Smith's PE Awards
