Sadly this week, we have received reports that some of our school community have not been respectful to other adults at the end of the school day. This has also been in front of some of our children.


Please help us to model respect and treat one another as we ourselves would like to be treated.

## Wonderful work this week




Who doesn't love a game of bingo?!

**Finley, Hugo** and **Bobby** have produced some great Maths work this week and are showing growing confidence.


Well done to **Alfie** too who has been working incredibly hard on his handwriting this week! Super effort!



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## Wonderful work this week




**Y3/4** have been so excited this week planning mythical stories in class.



his PE awards.



Fantastic technique and control
