

The children have also worked incredibly hard on their presentation too – your hard work is really showing, well done everyone!


Wonderful work this week

Well done to you both – super work!



The story is so exciting, with lots of original characters.


He has illustrated it too and even added code-breaker activities to really test the reader!

Superb effort. Well done!








