




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Celebrating our wonderful children this week ...

She also completed some division work in maths today, demonstrating her method of working confidently and enthusiastically.



This week she has brought 4 medals and certificates in that she has been awarded for her hard work. Very well deserved **Ophelia!** Well done!


Special mention this week

Gymnastics this half term. **Annabelle** has worked consistently hard throughout this half term and **Ophelia** has developed her ability both in and out of school






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Headteacher's Award


