Parents enjoyed the tree-planting session but raised safeguarding concerns about children moving through the gate from the field to the playground.

Response: Staff were present to supervise, but parents were responsible for their own children during the event.

Parents asked whether the school could raise funds by inviting local businesses to sponsor a tree.

Response: Mrs. Gaulton will explore this possibility.

Parents offered to support school trips and volunteer to hear children read.

Response: The Senior Leadership Team will review timetables to identify where additional support is needed and will update parents.

Parents requested more notice for upcoming dates.

Response: Termly events are listed on the back of the weekly newsletter, and the following week's events are included on the front page.

Some parents would like open mornings—where children share their work—to be held at the end of the day or combined with another event such as parents' evening.

Response: This will be considered.

Uniform was discussed. A few suggestions were made such as having a darker T shirt for P.E, so it's easier to keep clean.

Response: Mrs Hennessey is going to send out a uniform survey to parents.

KS1 parents expressed a preference for paper homework instead of online homework.
