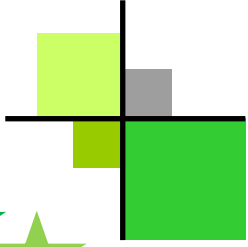

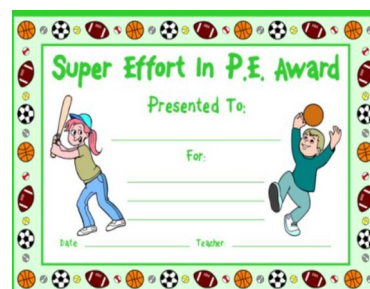


### Mr Smith's PE Awards
