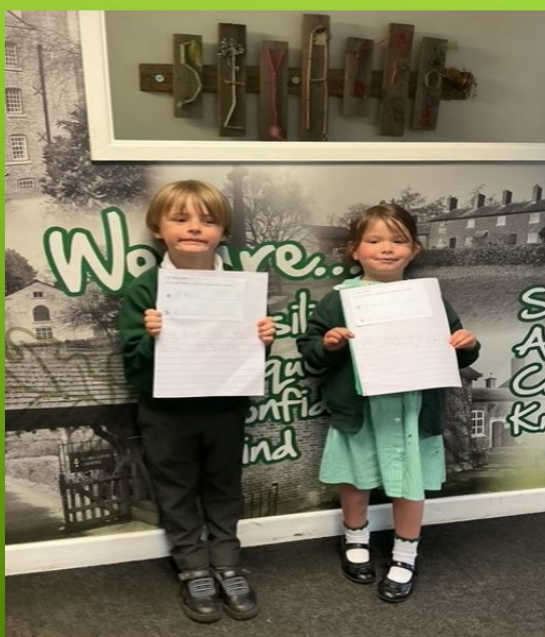

Very well done to you both, we can see so much improvement and progress in your work!

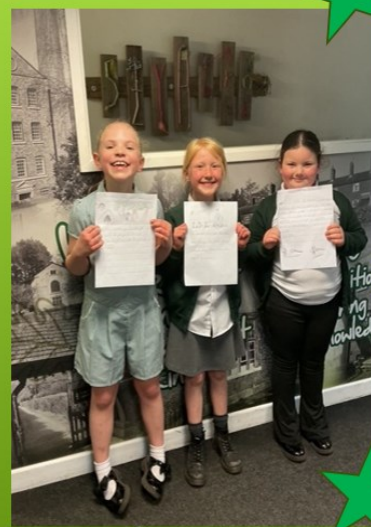

Well done to all of you!

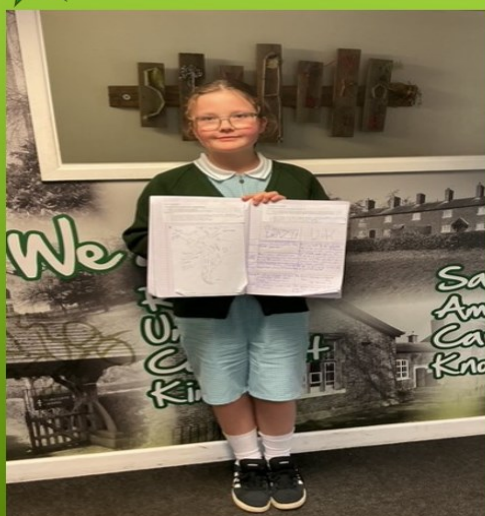

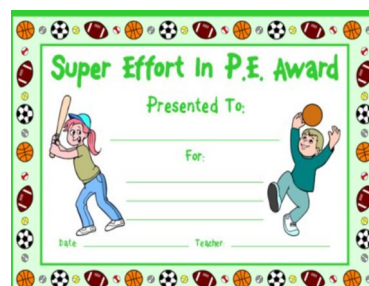


### Mr Smith's PE Awards
