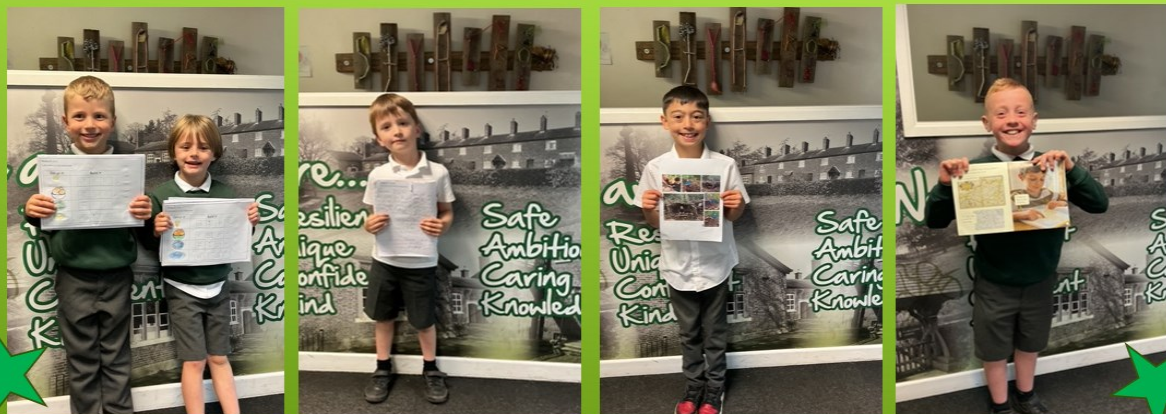

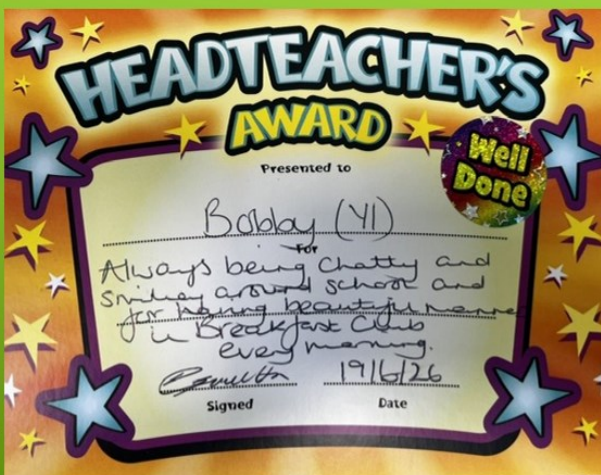

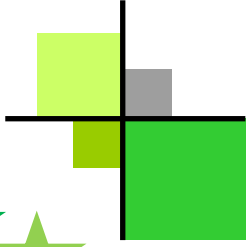
Headteacher's Award

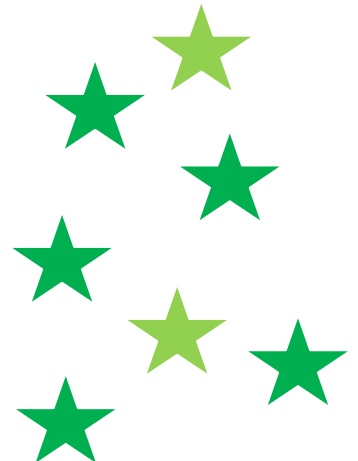

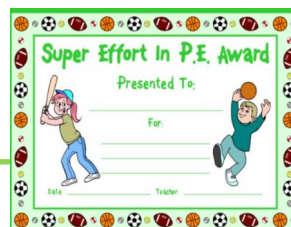
Mr Smith's PE Awards
