Have a safe and restful weekend.



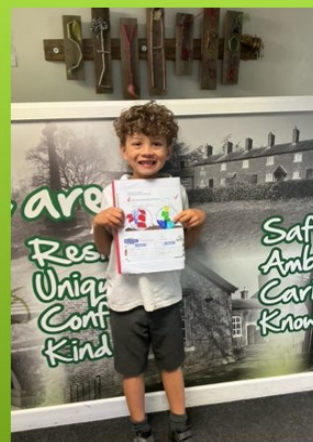
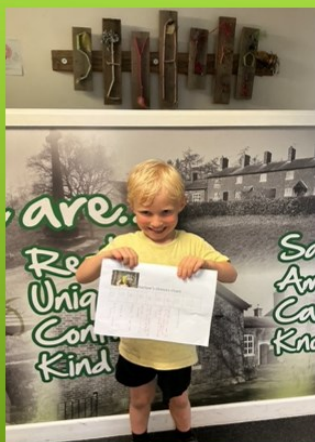
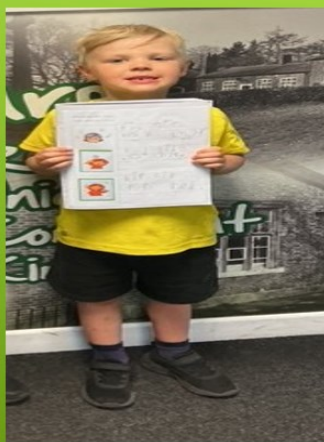
