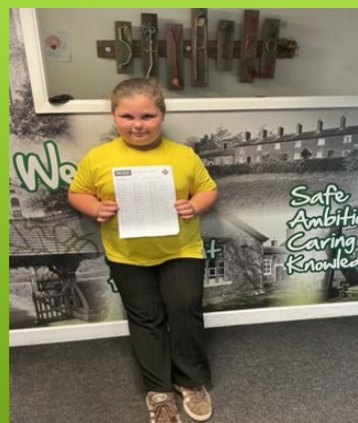
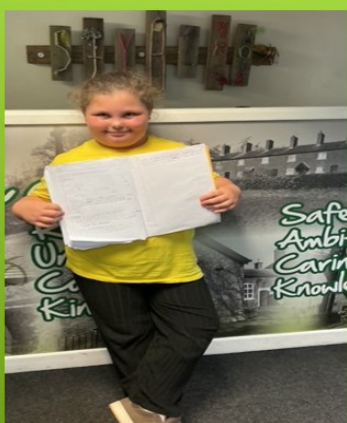
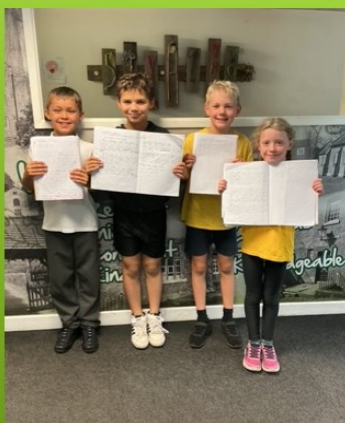
Harlow and Ophelia in Rec have worked hard this week on their independent writing. They have both completed a piece of work completely on their own.

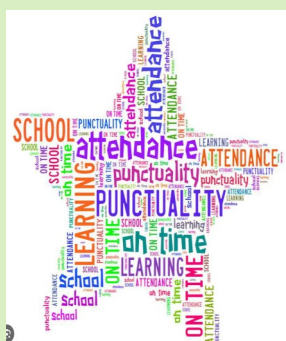

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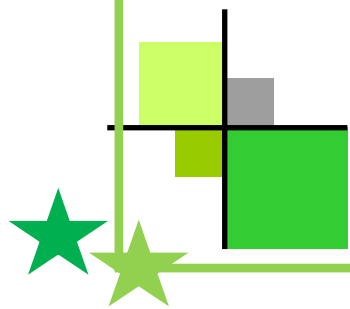
