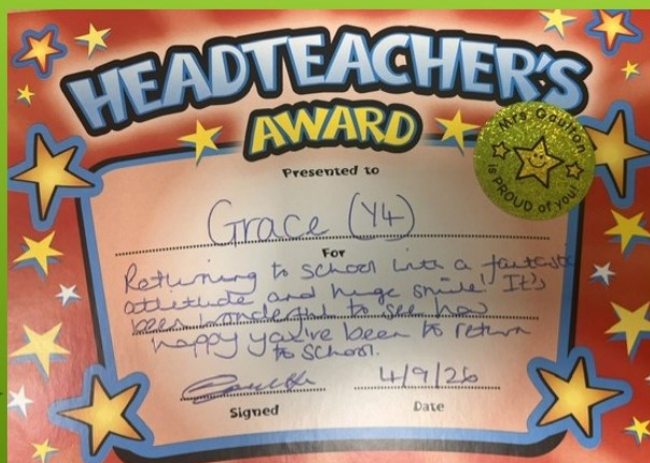


Beautiful work produced in Geography by Alyssia in Y6 this week.

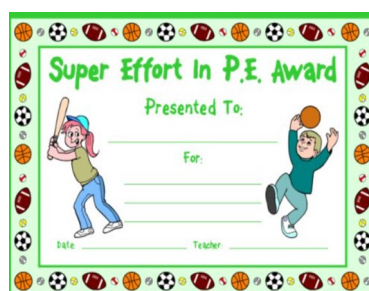
