## **SPORTS TEAMS & FIXTURES**



Football has taken centre stage in the sporting arena at the beginning of the year with a number of fixtures having taken place already, while our Year 6 children have completed the "Reading the Game" programme with the Shrewsbury Town Foundation. We have also had children represent us in hockey and at a bowls event, to which grandparents or parents/carers were invited to take part with them.











## **ACTIVE TRAVEL**

We encourage children to be as active as possible and one simple way to do this is by walking, cycling or scooting to school. This also helps us to reduce the number of cars outside school at drop-off and pick-up times, which is of course safer for the children and more environmentally friendly for everyone.

To promote this active travel, we continue to take part in the Living Streets Wow Challenge that logs how children arrive at school each day. Points are awarded for not coming by car and, at the time writing, we were top of the table for Shropshire schools! As part of this initiative, we held a walk to school event, starting out from the retail park. We were joined by a representative from the Woodland Trust who pointed out different trees the children passed on the route and who challenged them to find a variety of leaves on their walk. Year 6 have also completed their Bikeability training and at the end of that week, we invited "Dr. Bike" into school to provide free bike checks and repairs to all of the children. Thank you to the Learn Cycling team and the Bikeability Trust.







Can I once again remind everyone that if you have to travel to school by car, please make use of the park and stride car park opposite the Church and refrain from driving up Church Road and parking outside school? Police and traffic enforcement officers will continue to attend to ensure the rules of the road are being kept.

The Year 1-6 children very much enjoyed our visit up to Church for a special Harvest service led by Mrs Clarkson, Ms Hughes and our Pupil Chaplains.
