

Literacy We shall examine and learn to write : non- chronological reports, instructions and explanations, all based upon our work on our text 'Instructions ' by Neil Gaiman and on our work in RE and Science. We will also continue to improve our sentence structure in narrative writing and examine poetry.

Geography We shall learn about Volcanoes and Earthquakes. We will learn why they happen and where as well as looking at some famous eruptions and quakes in recent history. We will know how people are affected by natural disasters.

PHSE British Values and legal and illegal drugs will be studied. We will learn about keeping safe and how to help others with basic first aid.

Religious Education

We shall be learning about Judaism and examining why Christians believe that Jesus was the Messiah.

Maths This term we shall focus on division, fractions, and four operations calculations, then move onto perimeter, area and angles work in shape and measures. We will continue carry out systematic investigations in all of our areas of study.
