

Literacy During literacy, we will be looking at writing diaries and biographies. Linking to Art and History, we will be writing a biography on Faith Ringgold (Art activist) and Charles Darwin (Naturalist). Following this, we will be looking at narratives and how we can use descriptive writing for characters and settings to engage the reader.

Maths

We will start the term with Fractions and percentages. This will lead on nicely to ratio and proportion. Other topics within the term include sequences, algebra, converting measures and statistics.

Science Living things and their habitats—this will be closely linked to Charles Darwin and Evolution and inheritance. Children will describe how living things are classified into broad groups according to common observable characteristics and based on similarities and differences, including micro-organisms, plants and animals.

History/Geography

As you can see, this is a term full of work on Charles Darwin, we incorporate as much as we can within other lessons and the children will learn about his early life, subjects/species he studied, where he went on his voyage and the importance of his theories as well as his legacy.

Art—Print and Activism

We are studying printing, collaging and drawing. The children will look at Artists that express their opinions through art, using their skills to speak for sectors of society. The children will be introduced to the idea that they can use art to share their passions and interests.


Computing

We will be looking at digital literacy. This involves spreadsheets and using excel. We also look at how to use the internet safely and positively.

PHSE Health and Wellbeing—this includes basic first aid, looking after our mental health and emotions. Also, we will be looking at how we communicate with friends, understanding their emotions and feelings as well as our own.

Religious Education We are looking at Hinduism and answering the question- Why do Hindus try to be good? The following half term, focusing on what do Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people.
