As some of you might be aware, our School Chaplain, Judith Clarkson, is sadly leaving Shrewsbury to live close to family in Bristol.

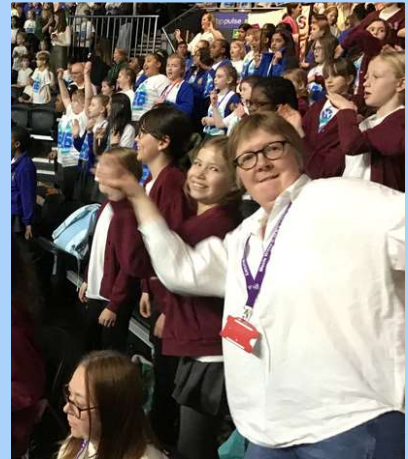
