

## PSHE

In PSHE we be focusing on People who help us, looking at safer strangers and who can help us keep safe. We will also be learning about how we can look after each other and the world around us.

## Art

In Art, we will be learning about sculpture and creating our own bird sculpture. We will be sketching and learning about different birds, then, we will be using different materials to create a standing 3D sculpture.

## Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about our local area. We will be going on a walk of the local area and drawing a simple map. We will link this to our work on Ordnance survey maps and map symbols. We will also be looking at human and physical features of Meole Brace, Shrewsbury and surrounding areas.

## History

In History we will be learning about Toys and how they have changed over the years. We will look at the materials they were made out of, placing them in chronological order on a timeline and discussing the differences we can see through observations.

## Design Technology

In DT, we will be tasting, designing and making our own healthy fruit salad. We will be practicing and refining our cutting skills, evaluating our fruit salad and suggesting improvements.

## Maths

In Maths, we will be looking at the composition of 2-digit numbers and portioning the numbers into 10s and 1s. We will be counting in multiples of 2s, 5s and 10s forwards and backwards. We will be problem solving using addition and subtraction facts within 20. We will be learning about measures - money, time, mass/weight, lengths and heights and capacity and volume.

We will continue our daily maths fluency to work on our known facts.

## Literacy

This term, we will be reading books all about toys- 'Lost in the Toy Museum', 'Traction Man' and 'The Forever Bear' and books about In the Garden- 'Oliver's Fruit Salad', 'There's a Tiger in the Garden' and 'Sam plants a sunflower'. In our writing we will continue to work on applying our phonics and choosing the correct graphemes, spelling tricky words accurately, punctuating sentences correctly, leaving spaces between words, using "and" to join words and clauses, writing questions and words ending in different suffixes. We will be writing instructions, descriptions and short narratives.

## Science

In Science, we will continue to observe Seasonal Changes in Forest School and looking at sustainability within the environment. We will explore the school grounds and learn about the different plants we can see. We will develop an understanding of some of the different parts of a plant and the jobs they do. We will learn to identify common British plants and trees and what plants need to grow.

## Computing/Music

In computing, we will be developing our skills using a computers and other devices and begin thinking about simple animations. We will also look at digital writing using devices. In music we will have some in class music lessons with Mrs Tann which will prepare the children for their whole class recorder lessons in Year 2.

## Religious Education

In RE, we will be learning about "Who do Christians say made the World?" and "How should we care for the World and for others and why does it matter?" We are going to be thinking about Courageous Advocacy and how we can make a difference to the world around us and our local area.

## Physical Education

To continue progression in PE, we will be doing Kwik cricket and Athletics, preparing the children for their sports day.

## PE Days



Our PE sessions will be on Thursday mornings.

All children must have navy blue or black shorts or jogging bottoms, a school PE t-shirt (red, blue, green or yellow), trainers or pumps to change into in school.

## Reading



Children will have 3x guided reading sessions a week with adults in class. They will also have an individual read with the teacher or TA, and have their book changed weekly .

Please ensure that reading books and reading diaries are brought to school everyday.

Children will have a library session every other Thursday. They will need to return their old book before getting a new one.
