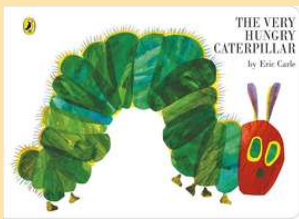

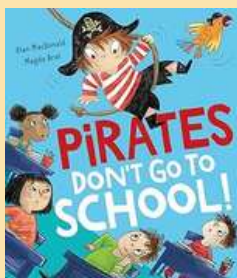

Below are some of the key texts we have enjoyed or are going to be reading in our classes this term – chat to your child about them at home.



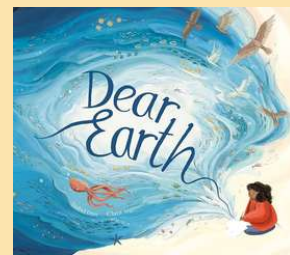

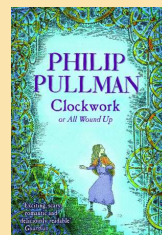

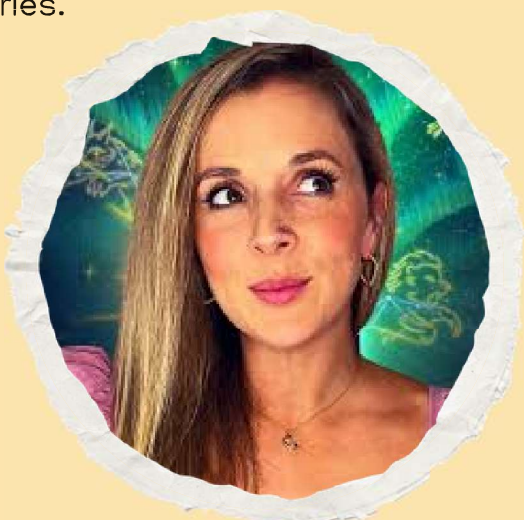
