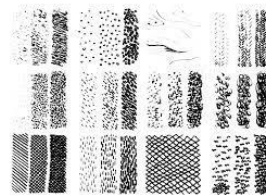
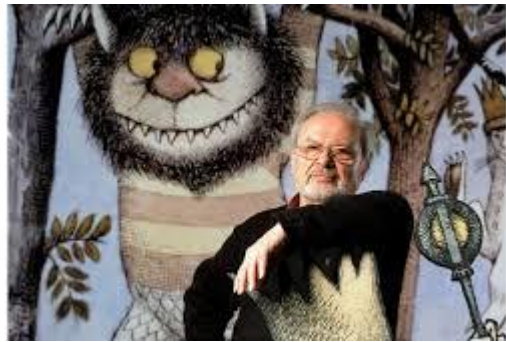

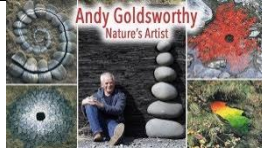

Primary colours	Red, yellow and blue. Used to make other colours.	Colour Mixing Red + blue = purple. Red and blue make purple. Yellow + red = orange. Yellow and red make orange. Blue + yellow = green. Blue and yellow make green. Red + blue + yellow = brown. Red and blue and yellow make brown. White + red = pink. White and red make pink. White + black = grey. White and black make grey. 	- To know how to create tints and tones by adding white or black paint. - To know how to use colour for effect e.g. hot and cold colours. - To know that some painters use expressive, gestural marks - often resulting in Abstract, Expressionist, Painting. - To know some facts about notable artists e.g. Vincent Van Gogh, Cezanne, Andy Goldsworthy.
