

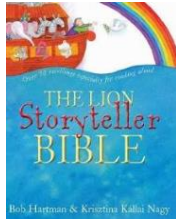

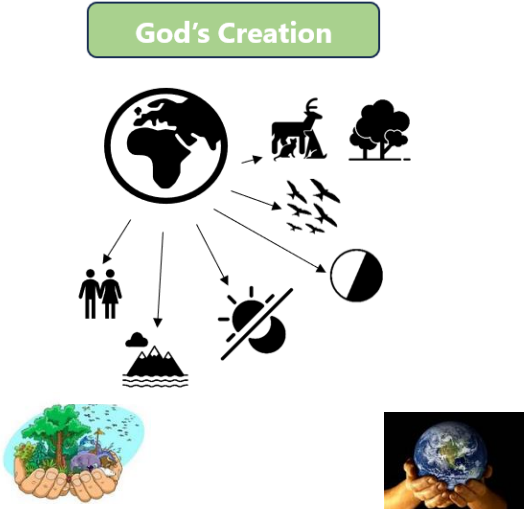
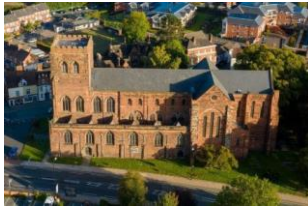

Hanukkah	An 8 day Jewish festival normally in December.			

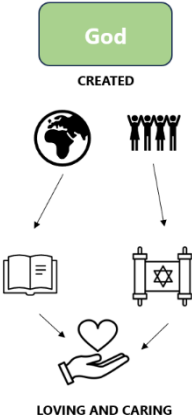
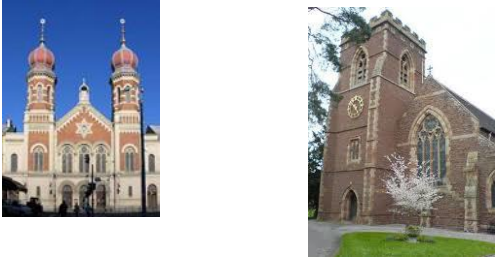
