Easter Sunday	The day Jesus was resurrected. He came back to life.			

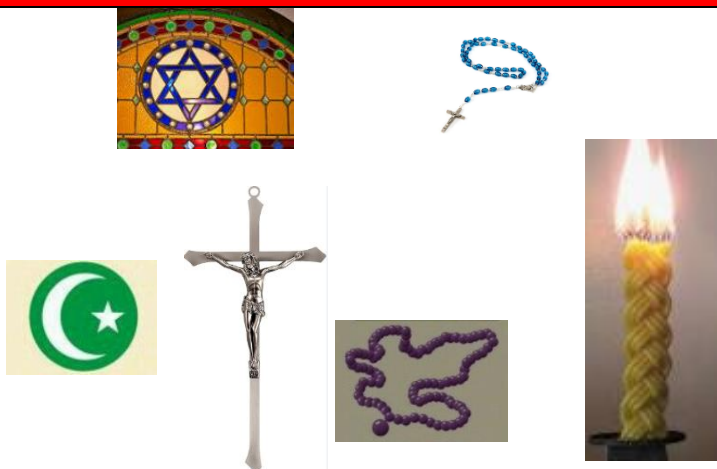
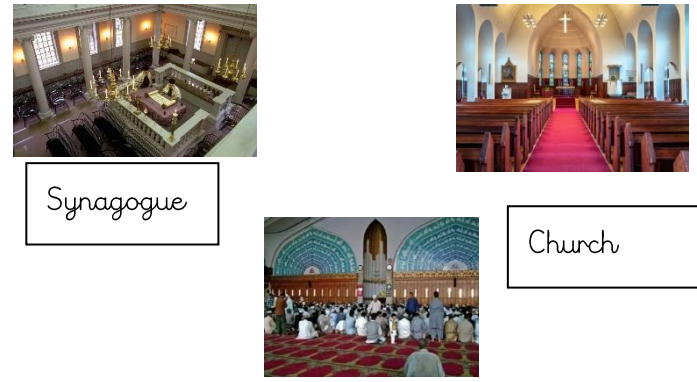
