When I count in twos from 8 to 28, I will say the numbers 16 and 32.

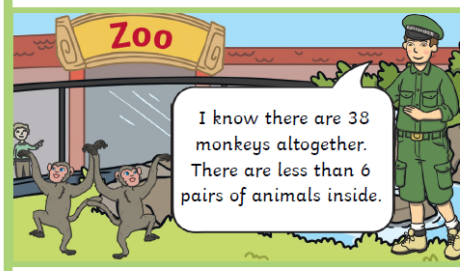
Do you agree with her? Prove it using a number line.
