I can identify **nouns**, **verbs**, **adjectives**, and **adverbs**.

Word Type	Definition	Examples
Noun	Names a person, place, or thing	<i>owl, tree, forest, wing</i>
Verb	A doing or being word (an action)	<i>fly, hoot, sleep, hunt</i>
Adjective	Describes a noun	<i>wise, fluffy, silent, golden</i>
Adverb	Describes how, when or where something happens	<i>quickly, quietly, softly, gracefully</i>

Read this short passage about an owl, then answer the questions below.

The **wise** owl **perched** **quietly** on the **tall** tree.
 It **watched** the forest **carefully**, waiting for a **tiny** mouse to appear.
 Then it **swooped** **swiftly** through the **dark** night.

3. Draw a box around all the adjectives.
4. Highlight (or colour) all the adverbs.
