Dear Parents/Carers,

A copy of the spellings for the following seven weeks has been attached and all spelling games are available on the class page of the website if you wish to download them for use at home. Each week, children have three, fifteen-minute spelling sessions that focus on the spelling rule, linking to the words they are learning. Children will be tested on these words every Friday. Within the spelling patterns for the half term are also sets of words which focus solely on the statutory Year 5 and 6 spelling list words.

When supporting your child/children please encourage them to talk about any patterns they notice within the words and any rules they know are linked. Additionally, clarify the meaning of any words they are unsure of and encourage them to put them into a verbal sentence. Finally, if practising with them, mix up the order, as it is important that children learn the spellings, not the order.
