RRAP Club Leader

It will be great to have our club leader in school every day and she is already a very established member of the Hartford Team. I would like to thank Mrs Liz Segrott for leading the successful launch of our RRAP Club and managing the provision over the last 9 months. Liz is moving back to Sandiway Primary School to focus on running their wrap around care.

Car Park Speed

Just a reminder that vehicular access for parents to the school car park is only before 8am and after 4pm. We had a near miss with a child accessing our RRAP club (access is now via the main entrance to school). A car was driving too fast through the car park just after 8am. Luckily no one was hurt, but it is incidents like this that remind us that it is all of our responsibility to keep everyone safe in the car park.

Attendance

A reminder that the school gates are open between 8.45am and 8.55am. Any pupils arriving at school after 8.55am will be classed as late and this will impact their attendance. Should your child need to attend a medical appointment (GP. Dentist, Hospital) that can't be made outside of school hours you will need to supply proof of the appointment details to our office team. For absences which don't fit the above criteria, please submit an 'Application for Absence' form to the school office either in person or via email. This form can be found on our website or hard copies are available from the entrance foyer.

A polite reminder that the school gates close promptly at 3.30pm each day. Please collect your child/ren and leave the school grounds as quickly as possible. Children should not be allowed to play on the trim trail or with equipment at the end of the school day and should be with their parents if they are waiting for older siblings to be dismissed. Thank you for your support.

Our after school clubs for children in Years 1-6 start week commencing 15th September. Please ensure your child's place is confirmed before you send them to a club and that you collect them promptly afterwards. The majority of clubs finish at 4.20pm, please check the club grid, which was issued last term, for specific details.
