Dear Parents. Carers and Families

What beautiful weather we've had this week, let's hope it brightens up again in time for the weekend!

Our Early Years team welcomed prospective Early Years 2026 children and their parents to school yesterday for our first 'Come and Play' session. This will be followed with our first open afternoon for prospective parents on Monday afternoon next week. If you or any of your friends have a child who is due to start school in September 2026 please do come along to one of our open events. Details of the dates and how to book are on our website.

Earlier this week, the office team sent out a communication about the school nursing team's upcoming visit to deliver the nasal flu vaccine to the children.
