## Grammar challenge: adverbials

Imagine that a great treasure is kept inside the castle and you are the hero who has been sent to find it.

Adverbials are words or phrases which give a reader more information about a verb or clause. Adverbials tell us about time, place, manner or number. Adverbs are often used as adverbials, ('I walked *slowly towards the castle*') but many other types of words and phrases can be used this way, including phrases which tell us when something happened (*early one morning*) or where it happened (*at the foot of the mountain*).

Plan your story below, using adverbials to answer these questions:

**When did you approach the castle?**

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**Where was the castle?**

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**How did you make your journey through the snow?**
