

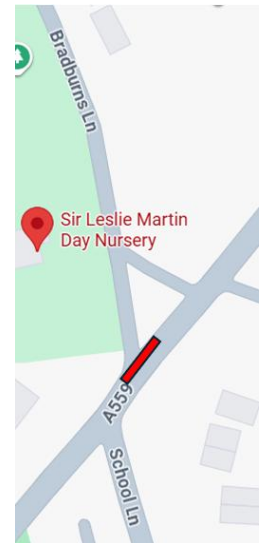

Hello,

Chester Road, Hartford (A559) -Temporary traffic management and road closure for emergency sewer repairs

We're getting in touch to let you know about work we need to carry out to repair a section of sewer on Chester Road, at the junction with Bradburns Lane/School Lane.

We understand that roadworks can be disruptive. However, traffic control measures need to be in place so that the repair can be carried out safely and as quickly as possible. We really appreciate your patience and understanding. We'll be working between 8am and 4pm including weekends. The red block on the map indicates our work area and the top section of Bradburns Lane will be closed throughout the repair period. The existing traffic lights on Chester Road will be suspended and temporary traffic light controls installed.



Our work is due to start on Saturday 27 June 2026. Until we've dug down and uncovered the sewer pipe, we're unable to confirm the expected duration. We'll provide updates on expected timeframes, but we aim to complete the work, reopen the road and remove the temporary traffic control as quickly as possible.

Your help would be really appreciated

From Saturday 27 June, and throughout the repair activity we would appreciate your help. To make sure our team have clear access to set up and complete the work, please can we request that vehicles are not parked on Bradburns Lane near the junction with Chester Road and also on the intersection of Chester Road, where it meets with Bradburns Lane and School Lane.

How this may affect you

- Access to Sir Leslie Martin Day Nursery will be maintained. Access to the nursery, Grange School and playing fields will be via Beach Road.
- Two bus stops on Chester Road will need to be temporarily suspended and our team will do all they can to keep traffic flowing and minimise disruption for the local community.
- Diversion routes will be clearly signed to direct traffic around our working area.
- We'll be using equipment and machinery which will generate noise and vibrations. You can still use all your facilities and appliances that generate wastewater as normal while the work takes place.
