Homework and Spellings

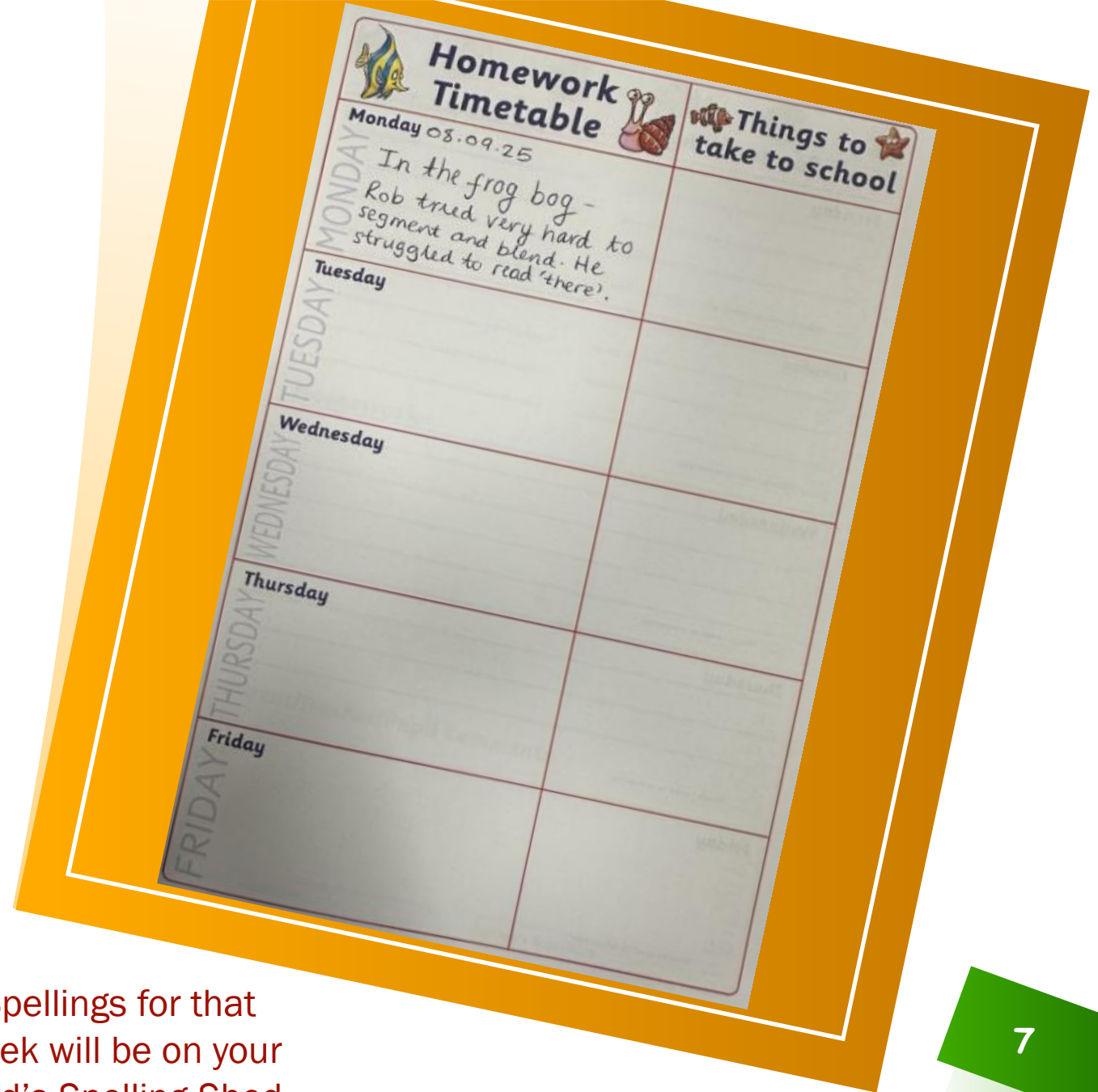
Homework is set every Thursday and due in the following Tuesday.

Numbots & TTRS

- The expectation for all children to be fluent by the end of Year 4 is now a statutory test. In Year 2 our focus is to be fluent in 2, 5, 10 times tables by the end of the year (as a minimum).
- All children have access to these platforms via app or website.
- Children should practice everyday to ensure they are fluent and therefore able to access the age appropriate curriculum.
- Difference in speed between some of our Y2 pupils is significant.

We have introduced a program to all year groups at school called myHappymind. myHappymind is all based around helping children to understand how their brain works and to support them in developing positive skills and habits to be their very best selves!

The curriculum builds on five core science-backed modules that your child learns about in class:
