PE – Thursday and Friday children to get changed in school.



- Make-up, Jewellery, sock trainers, leggings




# Homework and Spellings

#### TTRS

- The expectation for all children to be fluent by the end of Year 4.
- All children have access to TTRS via app or website.
- Children should practice everyday to ensure they are fluent and therefore able to access the Y6 curriculum.
- Difference in speed between some of our Y6 pupils is significant.



# AR and Reading Records

Accelerated Reader is a measure of a child's comprehension.

If they have AR books they will be able to choose from a level range, e.g. 2.2-3.2

Many Y6 children will be free readers with page number.

Y6 children can update reading records. Please make sure your child is reading for at least 20 minutes per night.




