Homework and Spellings

Homework is set every Friday (4P) and Thursdays (4F- due to swimming on Fridays) and due in the following Tuesday.

Homework will be either maths or english each week.

Spellings have been given out for the duration of the year. They will be tested on Wednesday (4P) and Monday (4F). Spelling shed follows a system 'Stage 4, list one' to 'stage 4, list 36'. This is the order in which the spellings will be taught and tested.



TTRS

- The expectation for all children is to be fluent by the end of Year 4.
- All children have access to TTRS via app or website.
- Children should practice everyday to ensure they are fluent and therefore able to access the Y4 curriculum.
- All children in Year 4 will sit a National Times Tables test in the Summer Term where they will need to know all of their times tables up to 12.



AR and Reading Records

Accelerated Reader is a measure of a child's comprehension.

If they have AR books they will be able to choose from a level range, e.g. 2.2-3.2

After each book your child will take a quiz and they will write their score in their planner.

Please make sure your child is reading every night. If they do please make sure their planner is signed.

How do I fill my reward card?

- 1) Planner signed every day by an adult.
- 2) Complete a book review.
- 3) Pass 5 quizzes in a row.
- 4) Your teacher might fill a box through exceptional effort!

you like.






Dojo and Aspens
